It is my pleasure to send you the enclosed safety evaluation for your product, Natural Cellular Defense[®]. As you requested, my team has conducted a thorough evaluation of the literature surrounding use of clinoptilolite, the component zeolite found in your product, and an exhaustive quantitative analysis of your product to ensure the identity and purity as well.

We found nothing in the medical and scientific literature that would indicate any problems with consumption of this product by healthy individuals. The methods used to prepare and activate your product greatly reduce any health concerns surrounding use of clinoptilolite. Specifically, these processes reduce the particle size of the zeolite to a safe and effective 5-micron size and also remove traces of other metals found in the natural deposits. Quantitative elemental analysis reveals no organic contaminants traceable to the manufacturing process, either.

Based on our research, it is the opinion of Eno Research & Development, Inc. that, in healthy individuals, Natural Cellular Defense[®] should be safe, if taken as directed.
